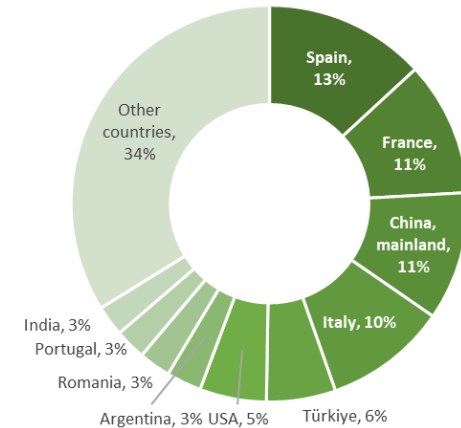
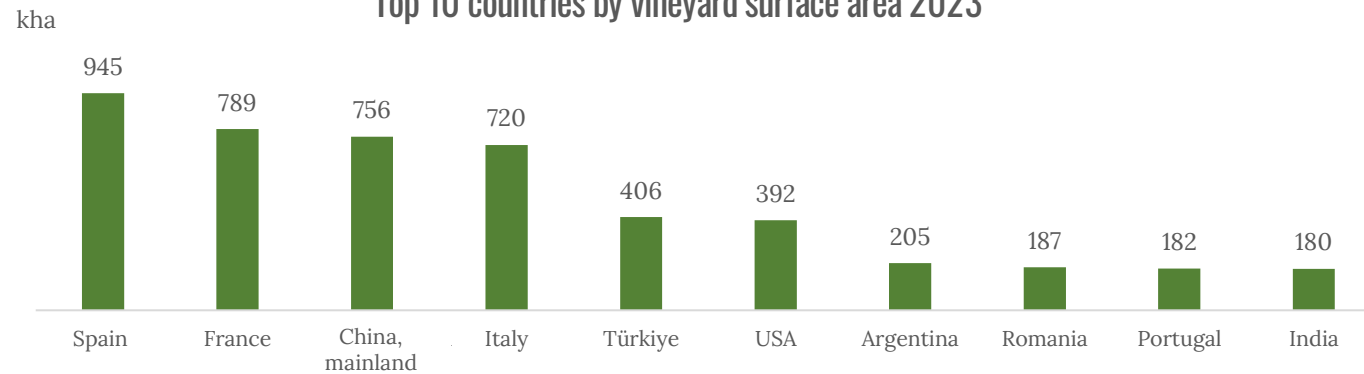
# Area under Vines

### Top 10 countries by vineyard surface area 2023







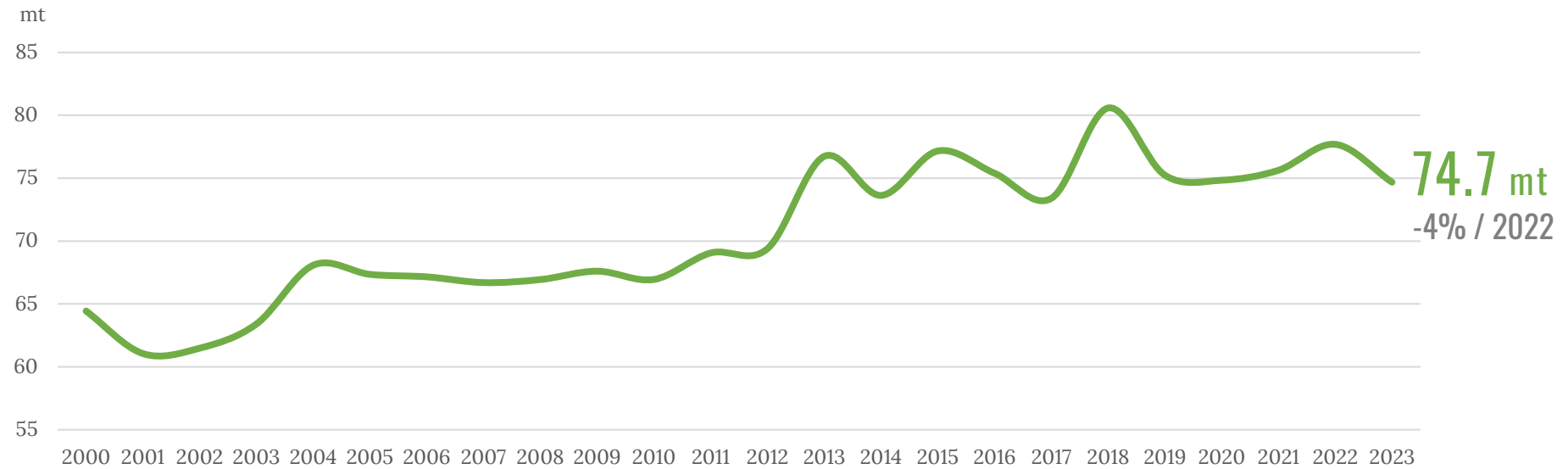

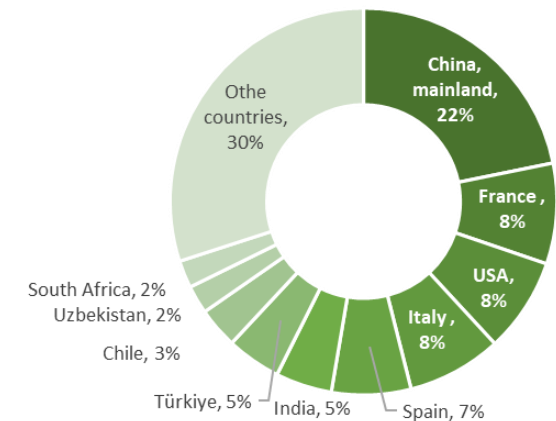
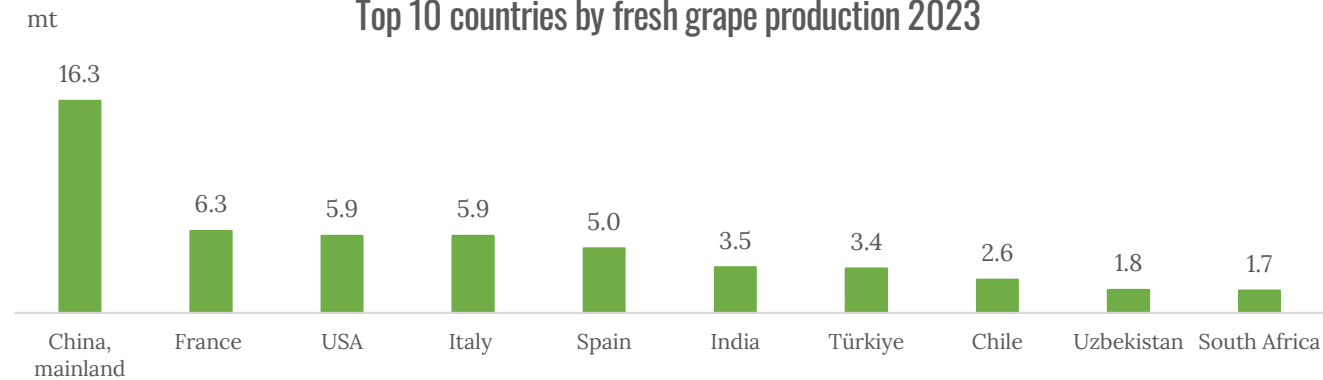
# Fresh Grape Production

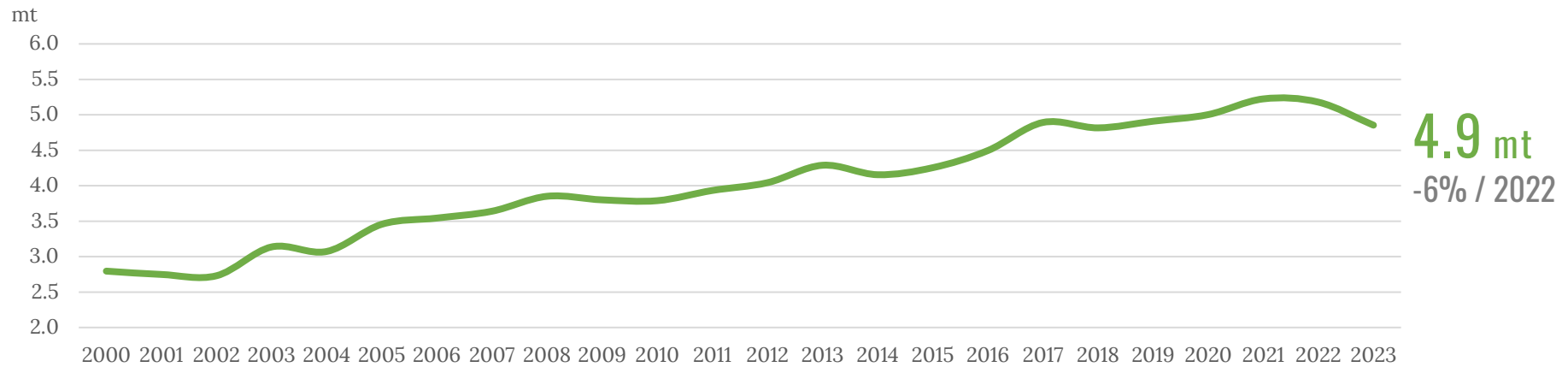




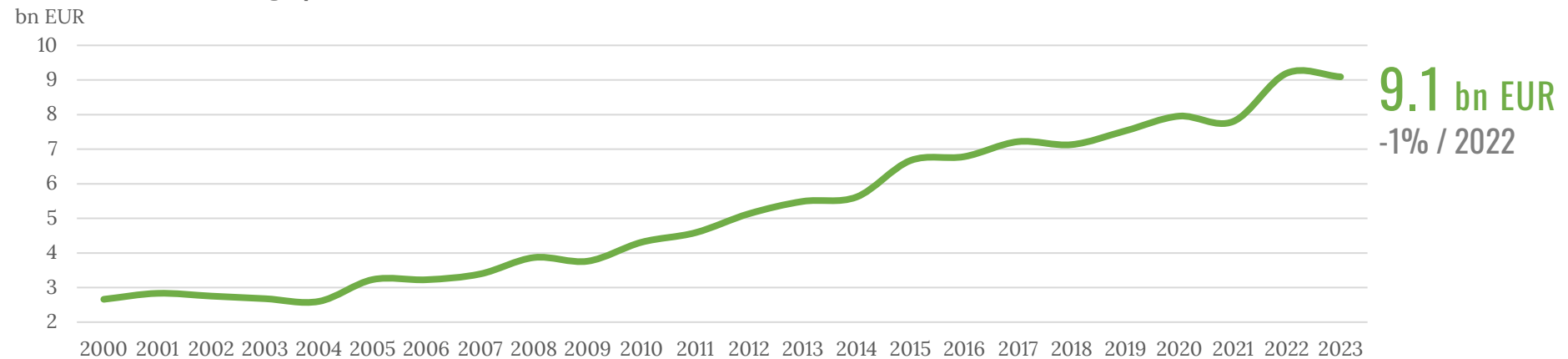

## Evolution of world fresh grape trade in value 2000-2023

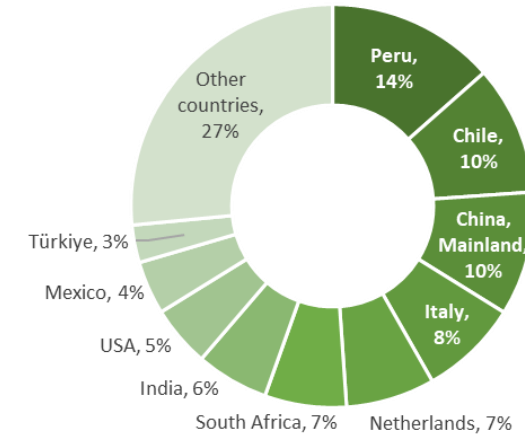
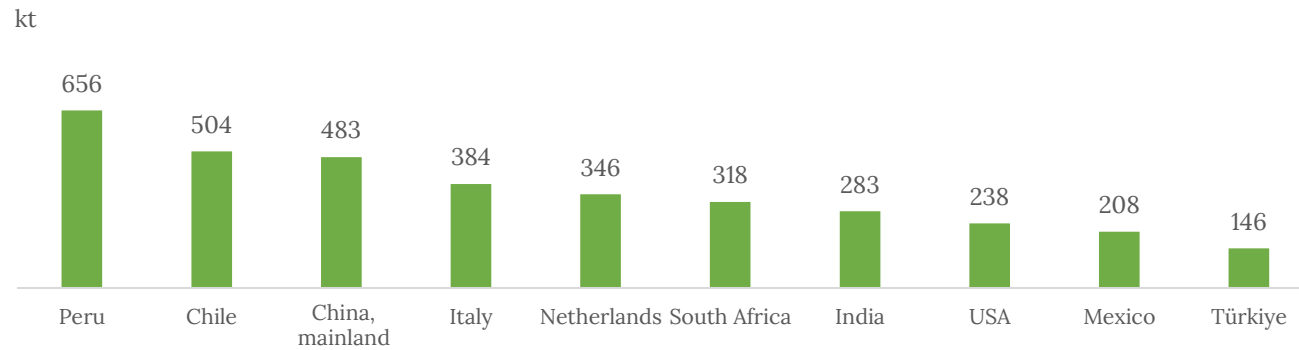




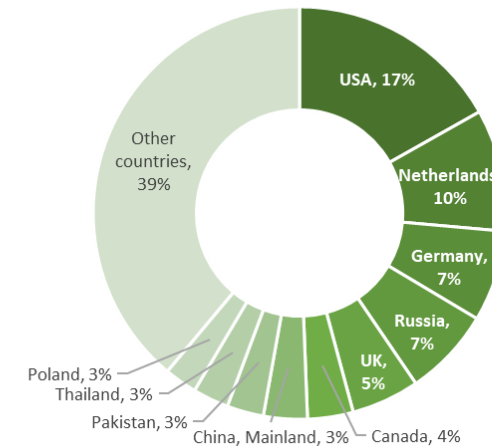
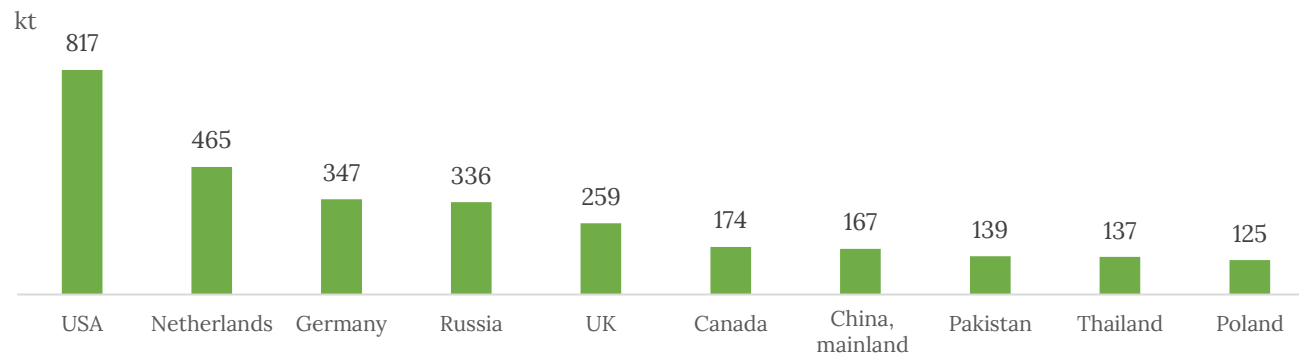

### Top 10 countries by fresh grape imports volume 2023





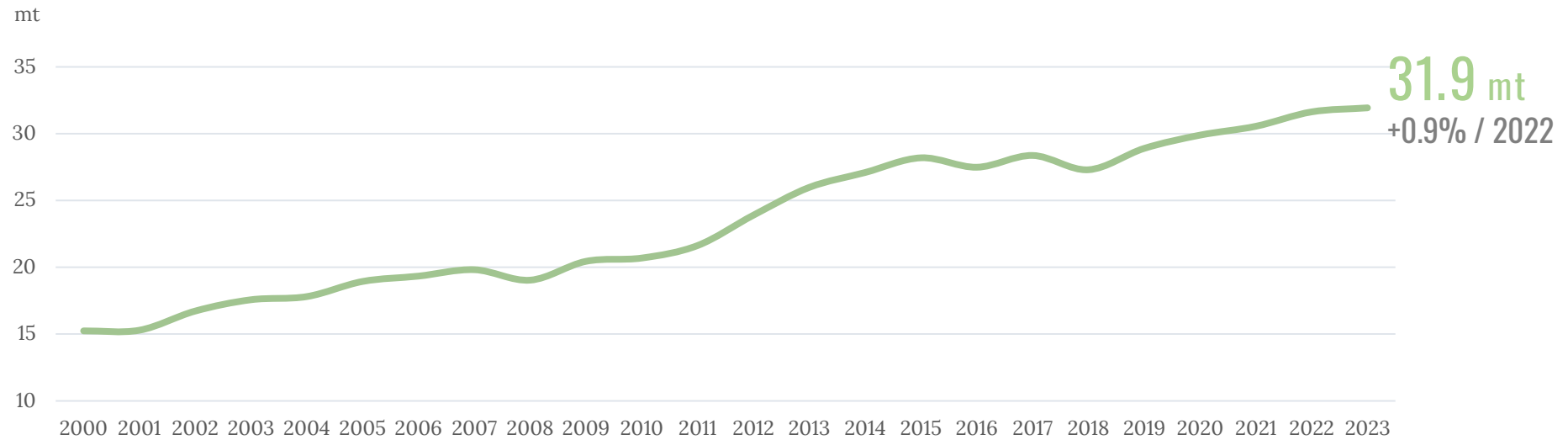

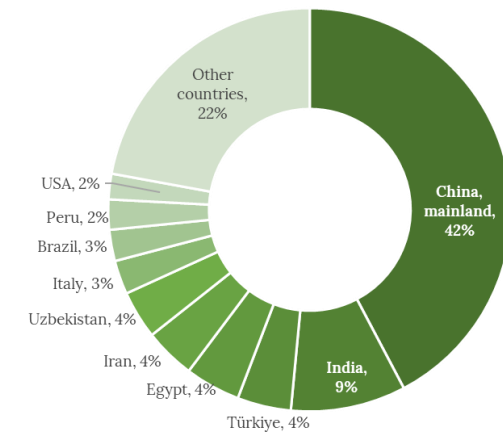
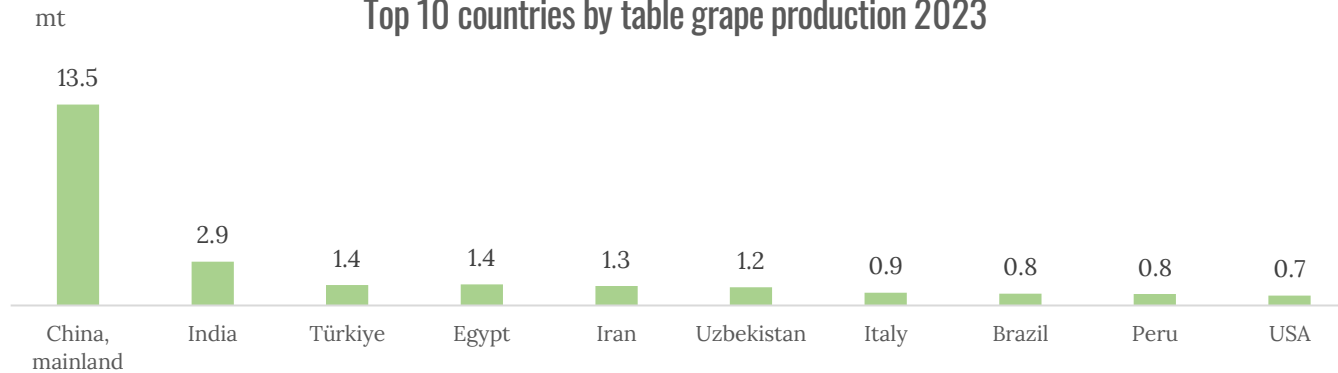

### Top 10 countries by table grape production 2023

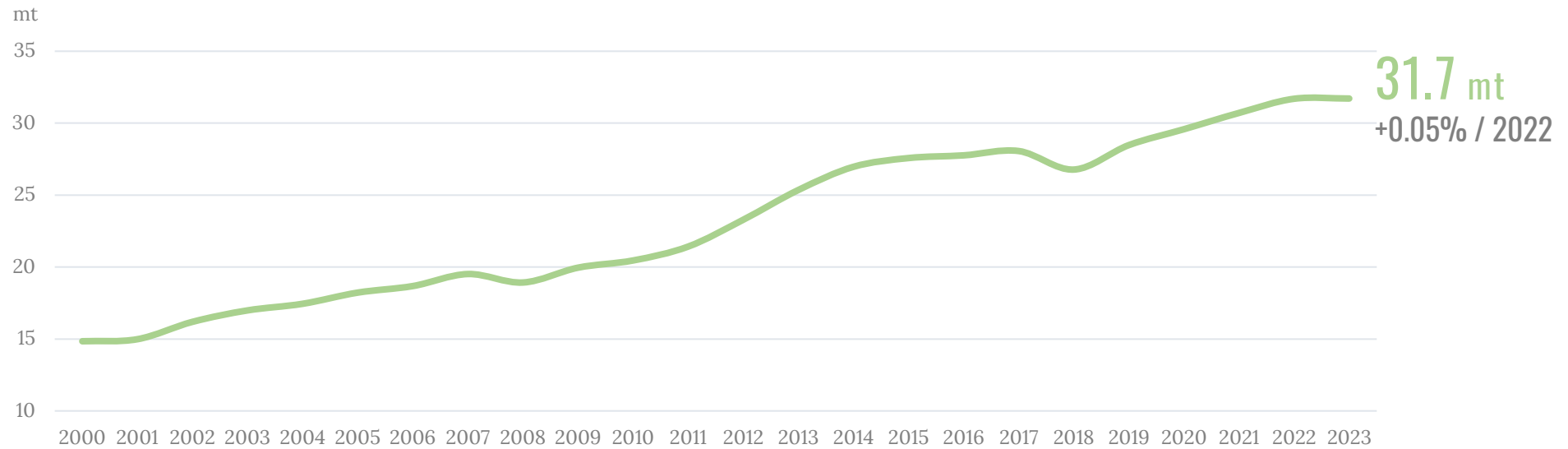




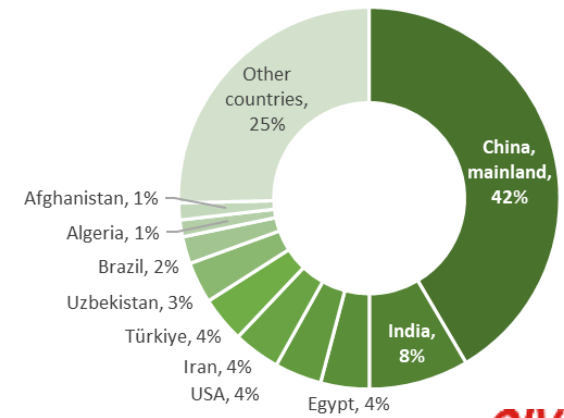
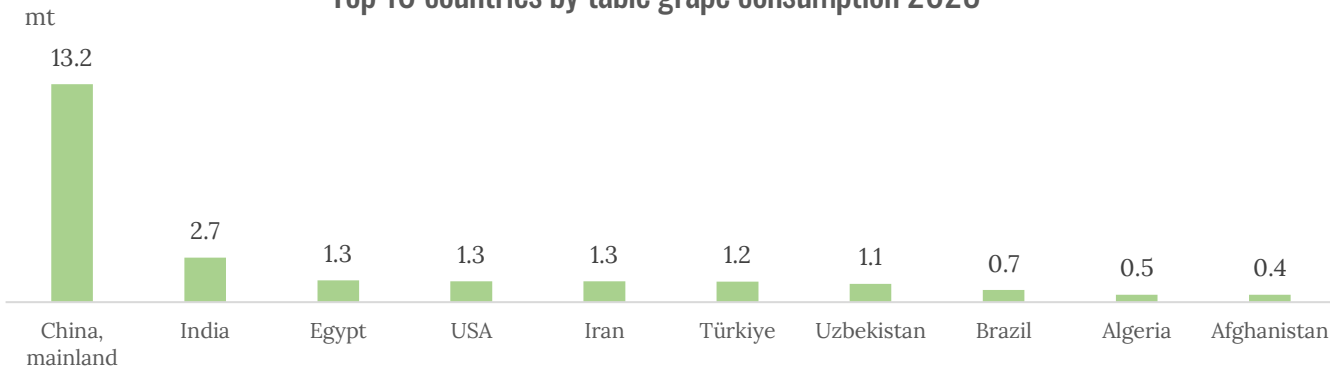

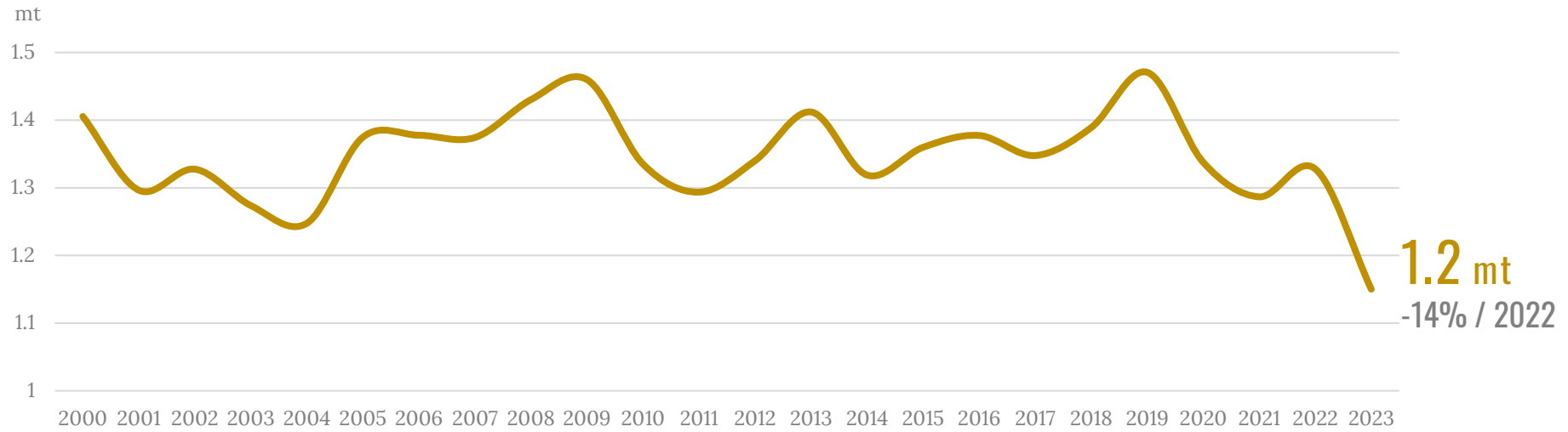




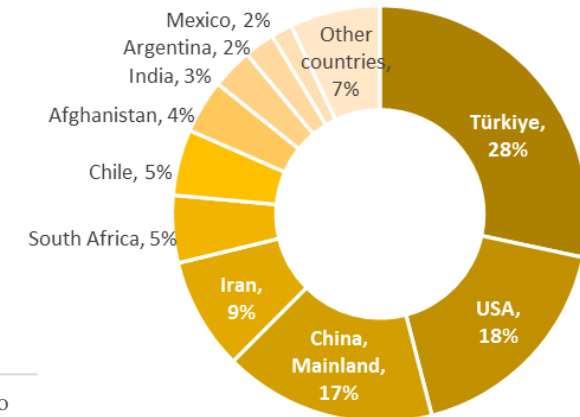
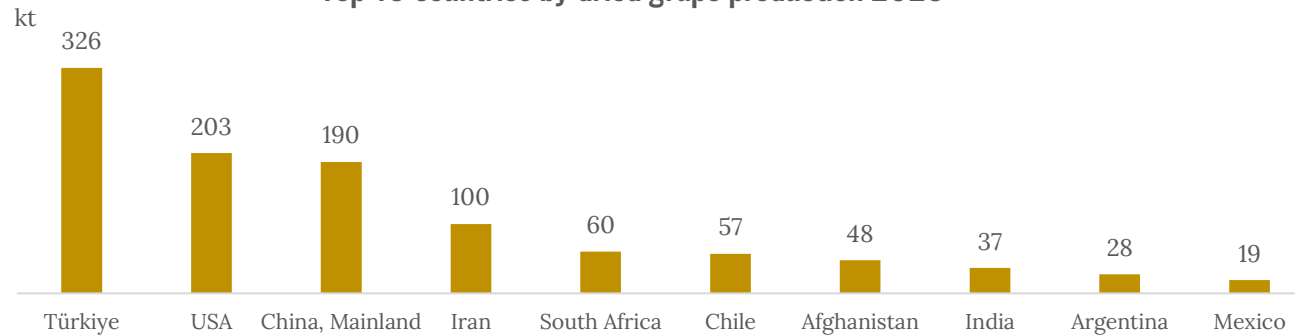
# Dried Grape Production

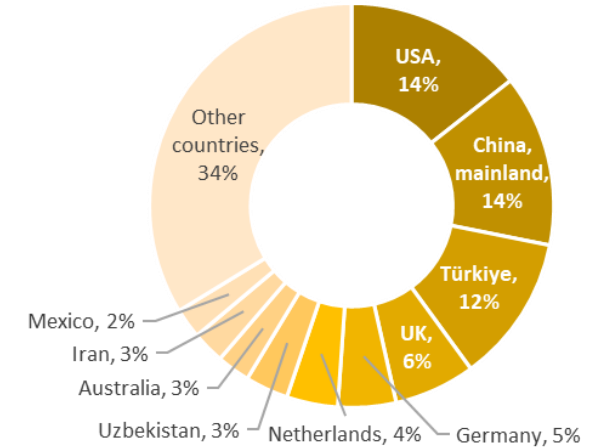

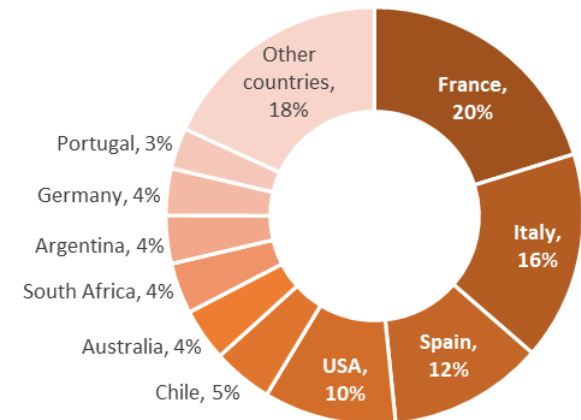
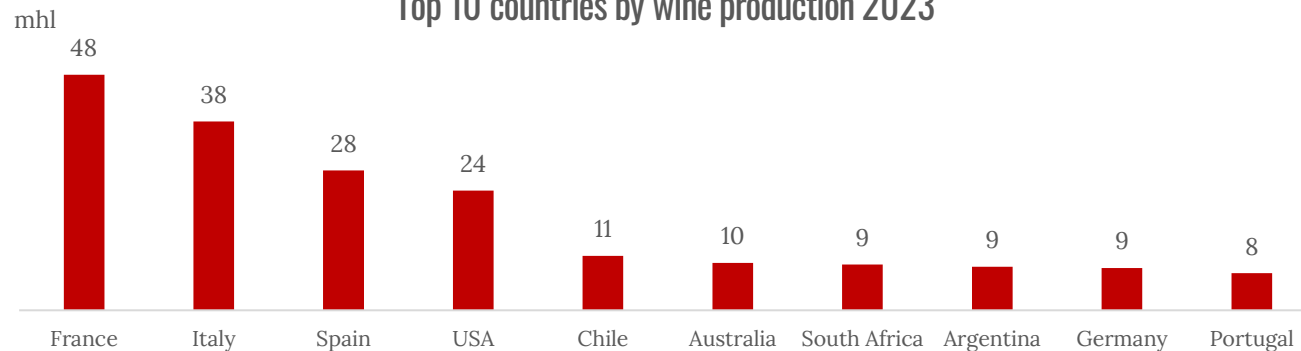
# Wine Production

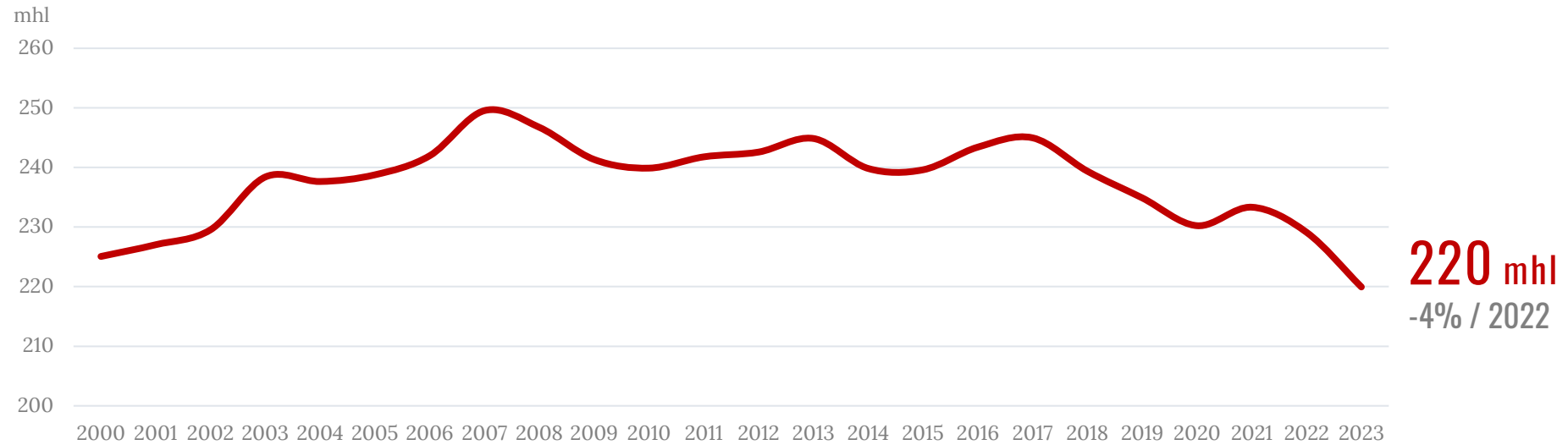




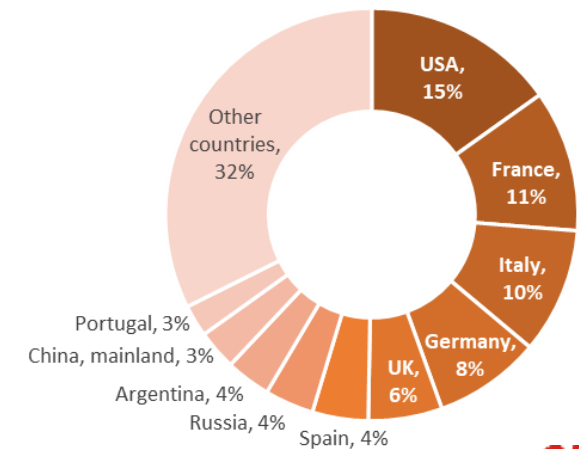
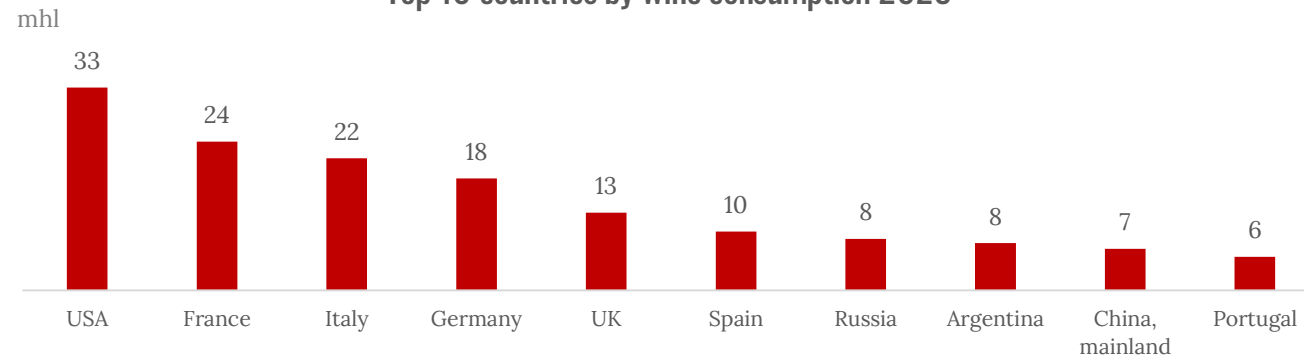
# Wine Consumption

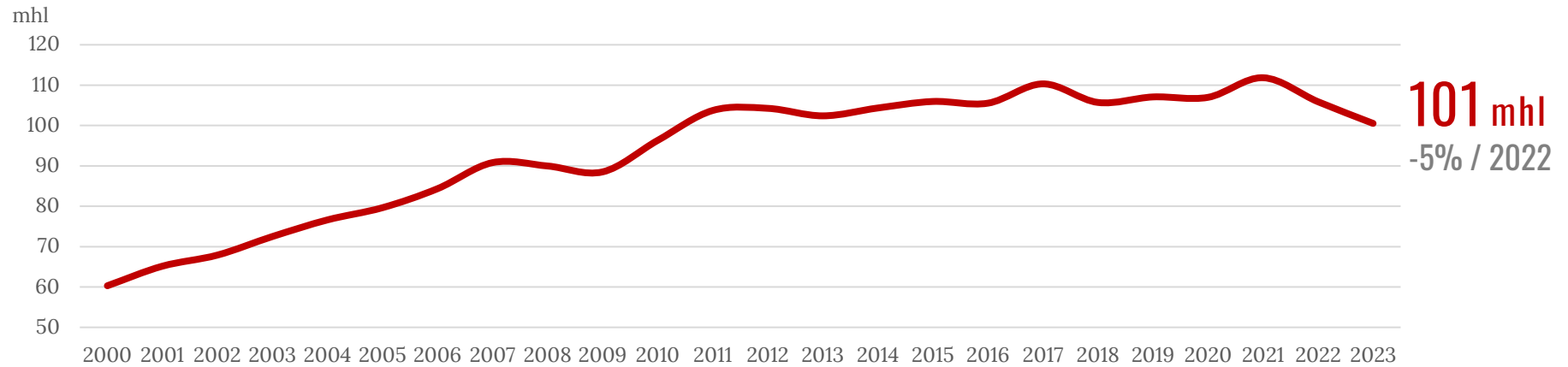




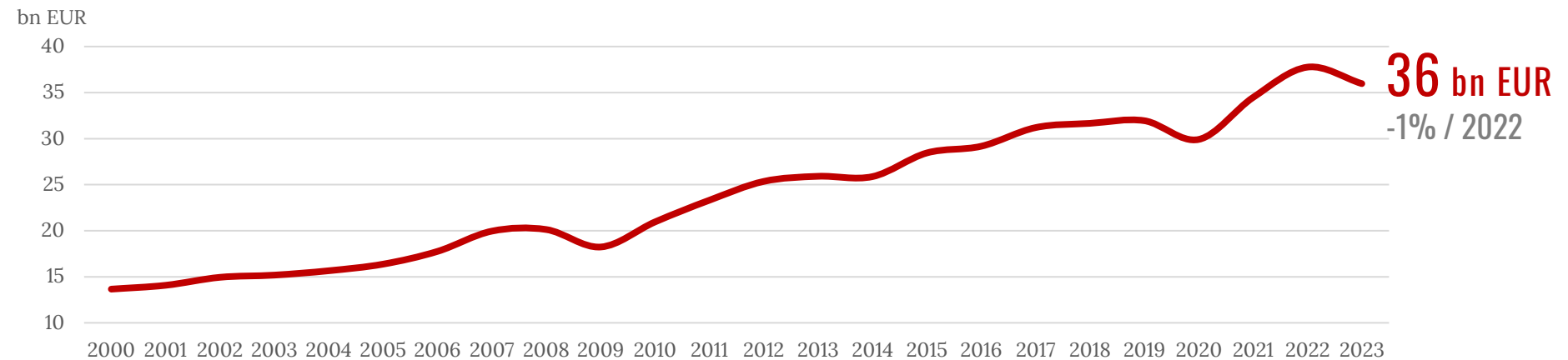

## Evolution of world wine trade in value 2000-2023



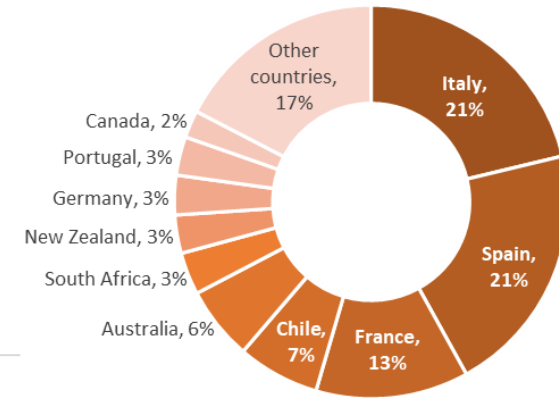
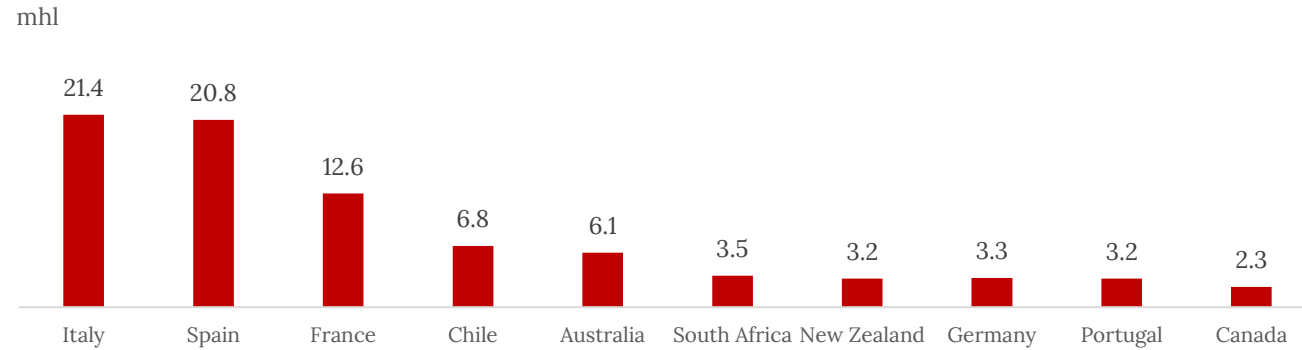




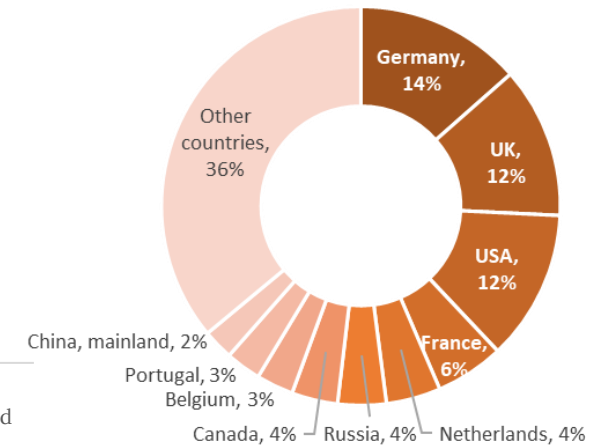
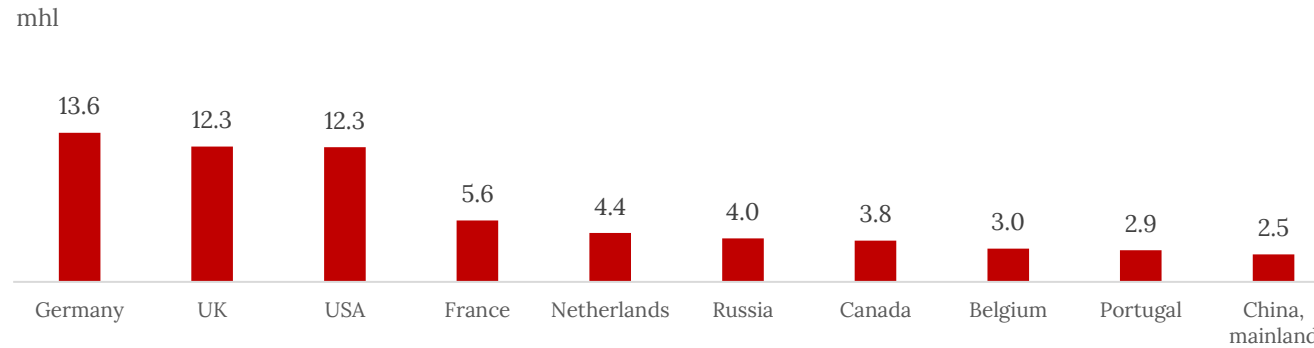
